

Cheese Puffs (Gougères) by Heathman Hotels

INGREDIENTS

— ½ Cup Milk

- ½ Cup Water — ½ Cup Butter
 - ½ Tsp Salt
- ¼ Tsp Pepper
- 1 Cup Flour
- 4-5 Eggs - 1 Cup Gruyère

or Cheddar

HOLIDAY

DELIVERY

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. In a medium to large pot, add: Water, Milk, Butter, Salt & Pepper
- 2. Bring to a boil.
- 3. Once boiling, add flour and mix using a wooden spoon or rubber spatula until fully combined.
- 4. Reduce heat to medium. Stir constantly for about 3 minutes until a thin crust (cracker) forms on the bottom of the pan.
- 5. Transfer the dough to a stand mixer with a paddle attachment.

- 6. Let it cool slightly (1-2 minutes), then add eggs one at a time:
- The mixture may look like it's breaking, but it will come back together.
- Ensure it's smooth before adding the next egg.
- 7. Once all eggs are incorporated, add cheese and mix until combined.
- 8. Pipe the dough into 1-inch circles on a baking sheet.
- 9. Bake at 350°F (convection) for 20-40 minutes, until golden and puffed.
